PLEASE REMEMBER TO SCAN PASSPORT WITH ENTRIES AND BRING YOUR EQUINE PASSPORT ON THE DAY.

Each horse or pony may enter a maximum of 5 ridden classes (including lead rein) per day, which must not comprise of more than 4 in any discipline (e.g. 4 Dressage, 1 Countryside Challenge or 1 Show Jumping)

No animal may compete more than three times in any class

Countryside Challenge – Outdoor Arena, **Dressage** - Indoor and Outdoor arenas, Callers must stand at E.

Show Jumping – Video entries only, **Arts and Crafts** – Gallery, **Horse Care** TBC

Change of Class must be declared no later than 9.30 am otherwise competitors will be Hors Concours

Please inform the Secretary as soon as possible, if any of the qualified riders do not intend to go to the Championships, this will enable the next highest placed rider, who has achieved the qualifying conditions, a place at the Championships.

Junior Riders may compete as Juniors until the end of the year in which they reach the age of 16.

Open Riders –The Open section is not age specific and is for all participants who have been RDA Class Champion for two years, compete in FEI, BD Para at Silver level or above or are an Independent Rider.

Mounting Blocks and ramps are available.
